**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act expanding the powers of the director of Fisheries and Wildlife.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 131 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following
3 paragraph:-

4 The hunting of deer by bow and arrow shall be permitted on any date, including a Sunday
5 or legal holiday, that the director declares as an open season for such hunting. Except as
6 otherwise provided in the preceding paragraph, an open season declared by the director for the
7 hunting of deer by bow and arrow, which open season period occurs in whole or in part, within
8 the last 3 months of the calendar year, shall be for a period of not less than 7 days that shall be
9 consecutive.

10 SECTION 2. Section 57 of said chapter 131, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
11 inserting at the end of the paragraph the following sentence:- Notwithstanding, this section shall
12 not prohibit or render unlawful, the hunting of deer by bow and arrow or the carrying on his
13 person a bow and arrow for the purpose of hunting deer, during any Sunday declared as an open
14 season for such hunting, by the director with the approval of the fisheries and wildlife board.
