Policy Regarding Hunting on Club Property

- 1) Policy regarding hunting on club property is set and revised by vote of the Membership at regular scheduled club meetings.
- 2) Hunting shall be limited to species and seasons set by the Division of Fisheries and Wildlife with the exception that hunting of rabbits while running dogs is not allowed in beagle pens on any portion of the running grounds at any time. (CSC rule) The following provisions of Massachusetts hunting regulations regarding dog training must be followed at all times. While training hunting dogs rifles and shotguns may not be possessed Pistols or revolvers and blank cartridges may be used and possessed but no live rounds. No sporting or hunting license is necessary. During the shotgun deer season running rabbits with dogs is not allowed.
- 3) Violation of game laws and or illegal or unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by the Carver Sportsmen's club. Individual violators will be subject to disciplinary actions at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- 4) Game wardens shall be admitted to the club upon request and shall not be interfered with by any member at any time in the performance of their duties.
- 5) The use or possession of alcoholic beverages while hunting or possessing firearms is not allowed on club property.
- 6) Hunting on club property shall be limited to members of Carver Sportsmen's Club and invited guests.
- 7) Guests shall be limited to one guest per member while hunting.
- 8) All hunters and guests must possess and carry all appropriate licenses, permits and tags required while hunting on public lands while on club property.
- 9) Members are responsible for guests.
- 10) The policy on guests hunting on club property is a membership benefit solely for the convenience of and enjoyment of Carver Sportsmen's Club members. Occasional guest use shall not be extended beyond reason. Our rule of thumb is guest use less than 3 times per year is reasonable more frequent use than that encroaches on the rights of paid members and the individual should be referred for membership application.
- 11) Hunting shall be on a first come first serve basis, conflicts will be resolved in a sportsmanlike manner. Proper consideration shall be afforded to those hunting from tree stands. Deer drives should be limited in size and appropriate to safely hunt a property of 300 acres.
- 12) Stands will be removed from club property within 30 days of the end of muzzle loading deer season
